A breathtaking piece bursting with colour and detail, “Yabang Barraba” takes you on a journey to remember the path you’ve taken to get where you are at this very moment. Featuring curved lines and traditional dot painting, this piece depicts the memories we surround ourselves of home while traveling – reminded of the smells and sounds that connect us to our comfort place. Representing the connection of land and sea, gorgeous bright orange, pink and yellow shades contrast with cool blue tones for a balanced look, symbolising the salty sea air that sprays your face, and the warmth of the sun like a mother’s kiss on your cheek.

Biripi Artist and traditional weaver, Joedie Lawler brings immense passion and heart to each one of her contemporary masterpieces. As well as a series of spectacular Aboriginal paintings, she has also delivered various commercial commissions using raw materials such as glass and fabric. Since learning her craft from a young age, closely taught by her grandmother in Taree, Joedie continues to express her views and thoughts through her original works of art. Using knowledge and experience from her upbringing, Joedie’s pieces often reflect her interest in human connection and environmental importance. No matter what she creates, Joedie hopes every viewer can connect with her work and find just as much peace in it as she feels the moment she puts paint to canvas.
